I would refuse You still

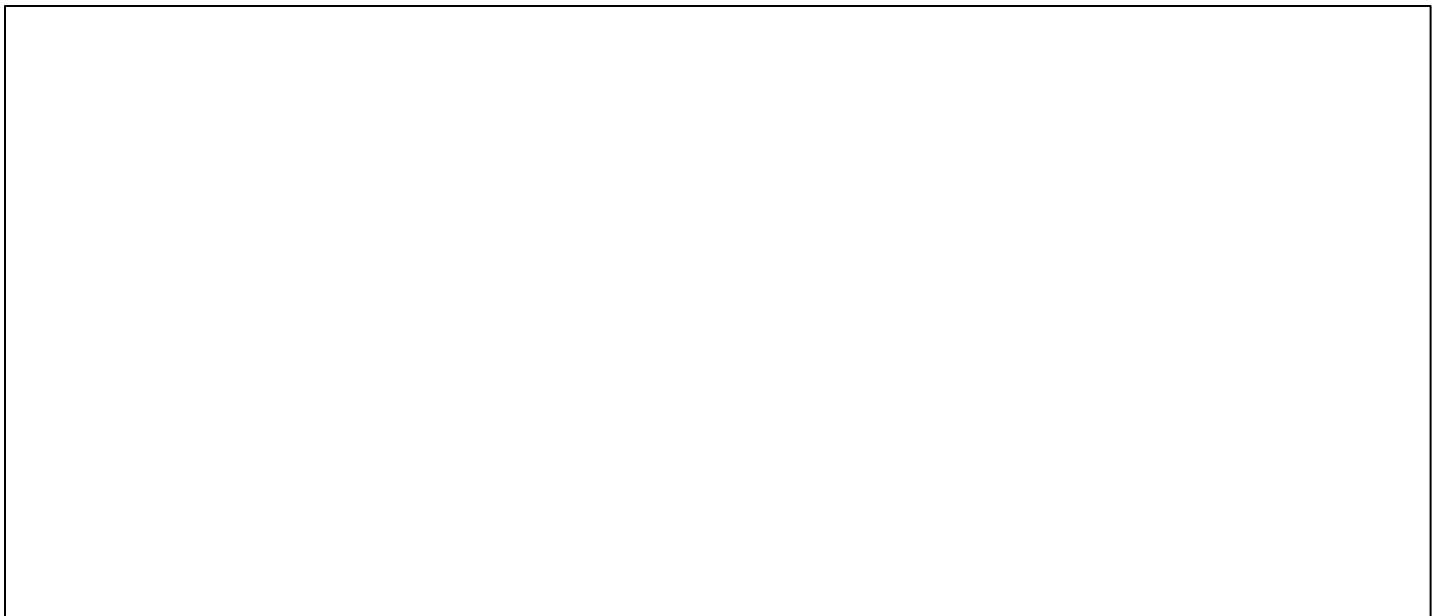
But as I ran my hell-bound race
