When they hear my Savior call

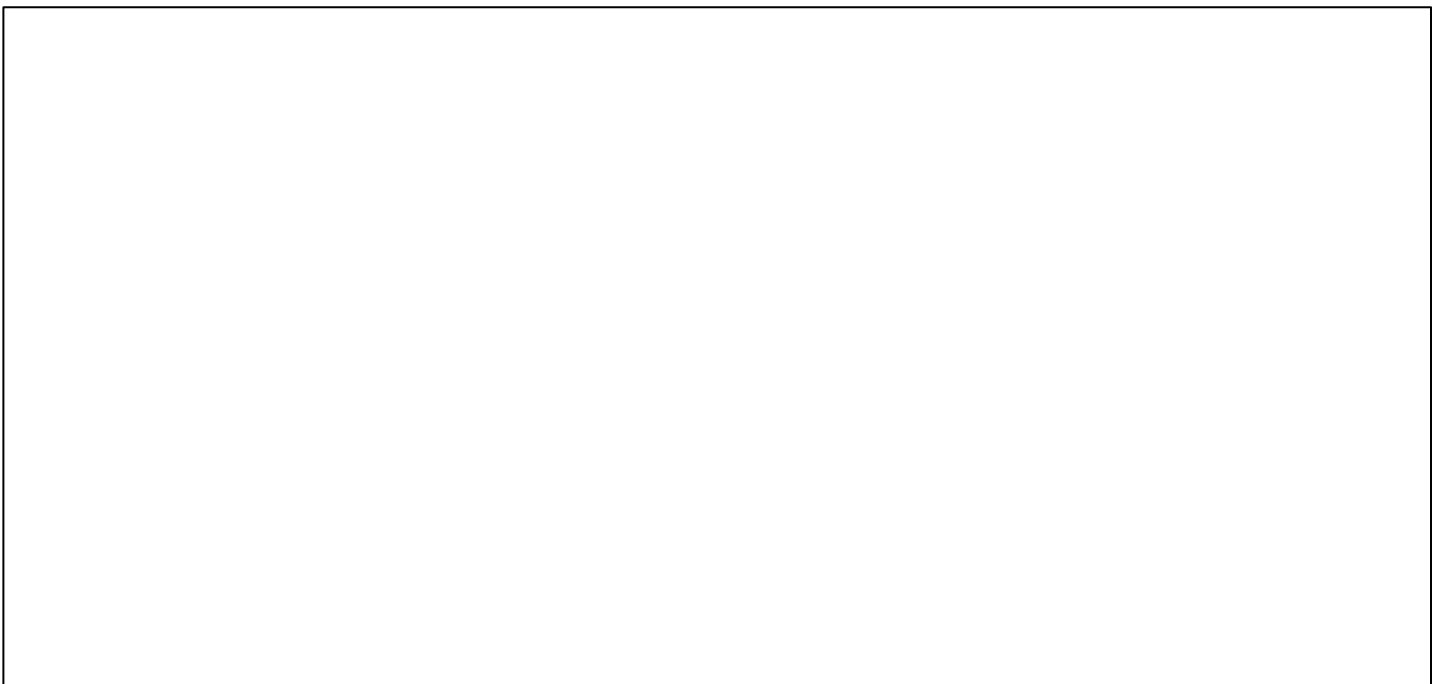
Christ Will Be My Hideaway
