Unending love amazing grace*

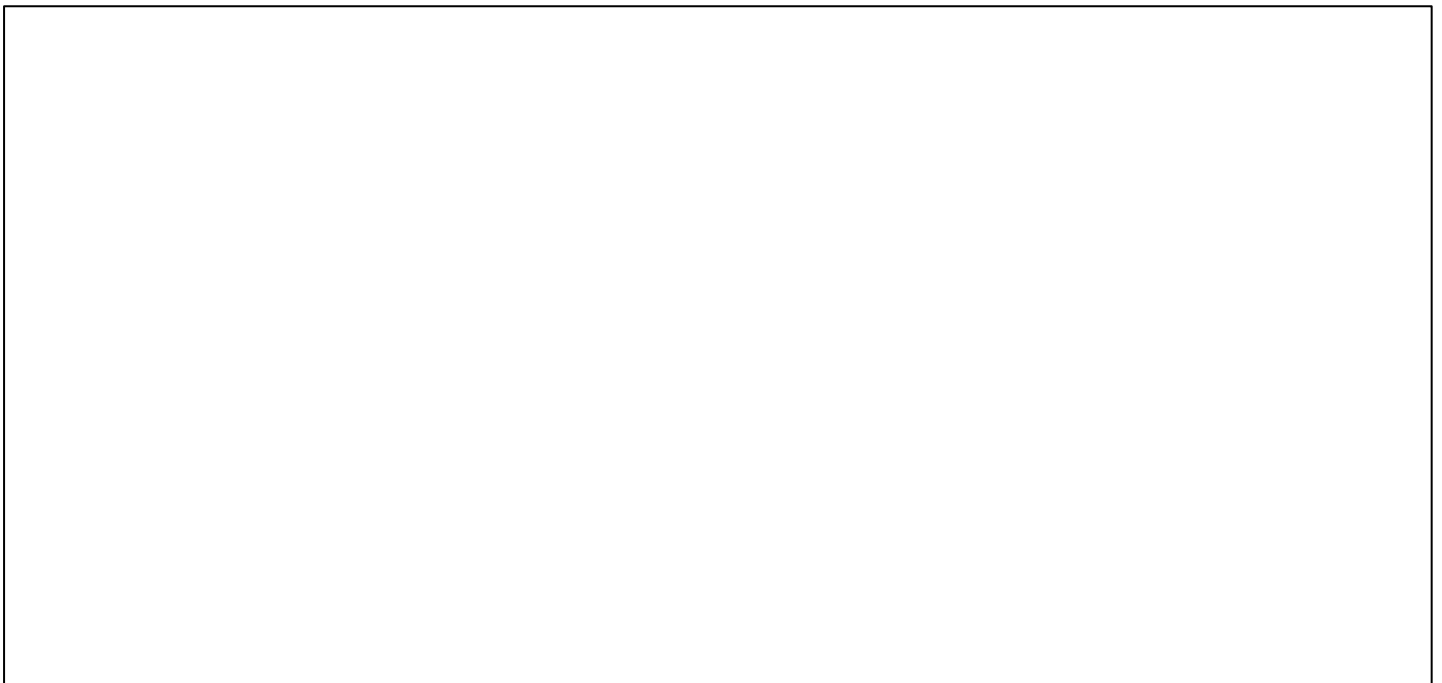
